On Saturday, May 5 starting at 9:30 AM we will be planting at a location just off Hwy 210. Drive south on Hwy 210, turn east on Whitemouth Lake Rd to get to the fire road. The block will be on FG Trail 31 north of Whitemouth Lake Road but south of the first hydro transmission line. This site is about 0.5 km away from the block that Scouts planted last year. Each youth should bring a shovel, bucket (to carry the trees in), a full water bottle, sunscreen and bug spray. We have permission to camp overnight at the picnic site at the Marchand Rangers Station.

ScoutLook in its current format began in 2010 and has been operated by a core 3 – 4 Scouters committed to providing Scouting youth with Outdoor Activity Skill opportunities that may not be provided through their local group or community. We have had campers from locations throughout southern Manitoba such as Virden, Gladstone, and Niverville attend the camps.
